- 4 Minutes of the January 17, 2012 Meeting and the January 31, 2012 Special Meeting
- 5 Award a primary contract for right-of-way mowing and median maintenance with SLM Landscaping and Maintenance at an estimated annual cost of \$142,423 for a one year contract and authorize the City Manager to execute up to (four) one-year renewal options with aggregate price fluctuations of the lesser of up to \$50,000 or 25% of the original maximum price so long as sufficient funding is appropriated by the City Council to satisfy the City's obligation during the renewal term; and approve Landworks as the secondary contractor (tabled at the January 17, 2012 meeting)
- 6 Amendments to T-Hangar Lease for the Grand Prairie Municipal Airport to restrict subleases to ninety days
- 7 Amendments to the Airport Rules and Regulations
- 8 Sublease Agreement for T-Hangars at the Grand Prairie Municipal Airport
- 9 Grant of Easements across city park property (east of Beltline Road and north of the soccer fields) to the Trinity River Authority for the MC-5 and MC-6 sanitary sewer interceptor project
- 10 Price Agreement Contract for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment (SCBA) from Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. (\$78,900) through an inter-local cooperative agreement with the City of Fort Worth. Authorize the City Manager to execute up to four renewals with aggregate price fluctuations of the lesser of up to \$50,000 or 25% of the original maximum price so long as sufficient funding is appropriated by the City Council to satisfy the City's obligation during the renewal terms.

- 11 Price Agreement Contract with Douglass Distributors for motor fuels at an estimated annual cost of \$2,350,000 through an inter-local cooperative agreement with Tarrant County; and authorize the City Manager to execute up to four, one-year renewal options with aggregate price fluctuations of the lesser of up to \$50,000 or 25% of the original maximum price so long as sufficient funding is appropriated by the City Council to satisfy the City's obligation during renewal term.
- 12 Contract with Larry Hulsey with Larry O. Hulsey & Co. for engineering services as the City's Gas Well Inspector for a one year period not to exceed \$325,000.
- 13 Engineering Services Contract with Weaver Boos Consultants LLC Southwest (Weaver Boos) for Expansion of the Landfill Gas Collection and Control System in the amount of \$77,000.
- 14 Purchase two 50,000 GVW tandem rear axle dump trucks from the low responsive bidder, Dallas Freightliner, in the amount of \$191,524
- 15 SCADA Maintenance and Repairs annual price agreement in the amount of \$68,460 with Prime Controls, L.P. and authorize the City Manager to execute up to four renewals with aggregate price fluctuations up to the lesser of 25% of the original price or \$50,000 so long as sufficient funding is appropriated by the City Council to satisfy the City's obligation during the renewal terms.
- 16 Authorize the purchase of a tax foreclosure lot located at 1925 W. E. Roberts in an amount not to exceed \$12,300 for the expansion of the Dalworth Recreation Center site
- 17 Resolution supporting the seventeenth-year continuation of the Police Department's Victim Assistance Program grant in the amount of \$80,000.
- 18 Resolution ratifying the City Manager's application for FY2012 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) for the State of Texas Division of Emergency Management for the Grand Prairie Office of Emergency Management to receive reimbursement of \$45,142.10 for emergency management program-related expenses such as salary, benefits, training, vehicle, office supplies, postage and membership/dues.
