Erosion Control Plans for Developments

An Erosion Control Plan shall be prepared and titled "Erosion Control Plan" for all projects. The plan shall include:

- The project name and address
- The proposed grading plan as the base map
- All proposed erosion control devices shown clearly as to location, extent and type using a distinct drafting symbol for each proposed type of device.
- A legend of proposed erosion control devices
- The following note "All erosion control devices shall be constructed and maintained in compliance with City Standard Erosion Control Construction Details, sheets ____ and ____ attached". The appropriate sheet numbers shall be used in the blanks.
- A 2 foot by 3 foot copy of the two City Standard Erosion Control Construction Details sheets as currently amended and numbered with the project plans.

Except for the single lot single family residential development, the erosion control plan for all commercial and residential developments shall be sealed by a professional engineer licensed to practice engineering in the State of Texas with competency in drainage design.
