**WEST NILE VIRUS MOSQUITO SAMPLE REPORTED
GRAND PRAIRIE TO GROUND SPRAY WEDNESDAY AND THURSDAY**

GRAND PRAIRIE—The City of Grand Prairie reports one West Nile Virus positive mosquito sample and will ground spray the following area for two nights on Wednesday, August 29, and Thursday, August 30, depending on weather conditions, starting at 10 p.m. This area is bound by Arkansas Road to the north, Highway 161 to the east, Warrior Trail to the south, and Epic Place and Waterwood Drive to the west.

Residents in this area are advised to stay indoors, keep pets inside, and cover fish ponds during those times. Spraying will be rescheduled if wind speeds are above 10 mph or in the event of rain. A map of this area is available at www.gptx.org.
