## GRAND PRAIRIE BIG EVENT SPONSORSHIPS

The Grand Prairie Big Event will be Saturday, March 28, 2020, from 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. The Big Event is one day for citywide volunteerism. We will pair volunteers with qualifying service projects. All jobs will be in Grand Prairie, vetted in advance, one-time only. The city is seeking sponsors for:

### **\$5,000 PRESENTING SPONSOR**

Logo top and largest on T-shirts, signage at kick off, logo on Big Event home page, opportunity for company to have a booth at kickoff.

### **\$2,000 ELITE SPONSOR**

Logo on all T-shirts as an Elite Sponsor, signage at kick off, logo on Big Event home page, opportunity for company to have a booth at kickoff.

### **\$1,000 SUPPORTING SPONSOR**

Logo on all T-shirts as a sponsor, signage at kick off.

### **\$750 DUMPSTER SPONSOR**

Your company name and logo would be placed on the dumpster at the kickoff site, and name on T-shirts.

### **\$500 – WORK GLOVES SPONSOR**
