

Municipal Energy Usage

Texas Government Code § 2265.001(b) requires cities to publish the following information annually on their website:

- "metered amount of electricity, water or natural gas consumed"; and
- the "aggregate costs for those utility services".

This report is consistent with the statutory direction to governmental entities to report the aggregate (combined) costs for electric, water and natural gas services.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2021 is \$23,149,765.99

Natural Gas

The City of Grand Prairie purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In Calendar Year 2021, the City purchased a total of **273,908 cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas**.

Electricity

The City purchases electricity from Gexa Energy. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of **39,202,572 kilowatt hours**.

Water

The City purchases water from the following cities: Dallas, Fort Worth, Midlothian and Mansfield. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of **8,930,856 gallons of water**.
