The Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) program is a Federally funded program regulated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), managed, and operated in the City of Grand Prairie by the Department of Housing & Neighborhood Services. The funding source for the TBRA program is HOME-ARP grant.

The purpose of the TBRA program is to provide rental housing assistance to qualified individuals and families in need of decent affordable housing. Housing assistance is provided only for rental assistance, security deposits, and utility deposits.

Primary Target Populations Include:

HOME-ARP funds must be used to primarily benefit individuals or families from the following qualifying populations:

Experiencing Homelessness

At-risk of Homelessness

Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking

Other populations with a high risk of housing instability (including households that are low-income and highly cost-burdened).

Veterans and families that include a veteran family member that meet one of the preceding criteria
