Children's Policy

Ages 0-8: A parent or caregiver (Ages 18+) must remain in the immediate vicinity of the child.

Ages 9-13: A parent or caregiver (Ages 18+) must remain in the building with the child.

Ages 14-17: May use the library independently, provided they follow library policies.

CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT IN THE PLAY SPACE AREA AT ALL TIMES.

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HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD

The Grand Prairie Library System issues physical (plastic) library cards in person, or digital library cards via email. To receive a library card number by email, read all the information below and scan the QR code and fill out the application form. A parent must submit an application on behalf of a minor.

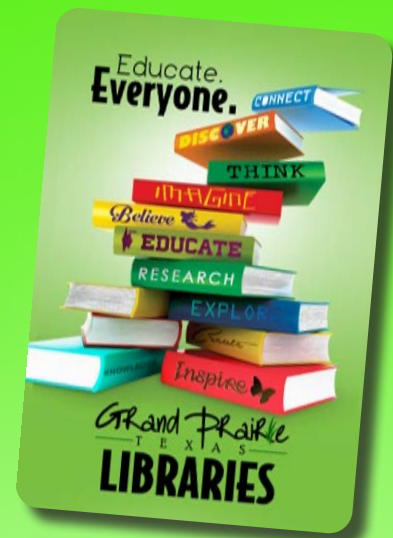
HOW SOON WILL I RECEIVE MY LIBRARY CARD NUMBER?

In most cases we are able to issue a digital card within 24 hours. Applications received after 3 p.m. on Saturday or received on a Sunday may not be processed until Monday. If you apply for a card online, you will not receive a physical card. To exchange your digital card number for a physical card, visit any library branch during open hours.

CHECKOUT GUIDELINES

New library accounts will be placed in an introductory period for the first three weeks. This allows for the checkout of 10 books and 10 movies at a time. Accounts will be moved from introductory status after the three-week period as long as they are in good standing. Accounts no longer in introductory status can checkout up to 40 items, this includes 20 books and 20 movies.

All items checkout for a period of three weeks. Most items automatically renew for an additional three weeks up to three times as long as they are not on request. Renewal notifications will be sent via e-mail. There is a fee for materials returned late. .25¢ per day, per book and \$1.00 per day, per movie.

Un padre debe presentar una solicitud en nombre de un menor.

¿CUÁNTO PRONTO RECIBIRÉ MI NÚMERO DE TARJETA DE BIBLIOTECA?

En la mayoría de los casos podemos emitir una tarjeta digital en un plazo de 24 horas. Solicitudes recibidas después de las 3 p.m. el Sábado o recibido el Domingo, es posible que no se procese hasta el Lunes. Si solicita una tarjeta en línea, no recibirá una tarjeta física. Para cambiar tu número de tarjeta digital para obtener una tarjeta física, visite cualquier sucursal de la biblioteca durante el horario de atención.

DIRECTRICES DE PAGO
