

CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY INSPECTION CHECKLIST

FIRE BASIC SAFETY REQUIREMENTS (2021 International Fire Code – IFC and IPMC)

{This is a general guide of common items and may not be all inclusive; all items may not apply to all locations}

Ш	FIRE LANES. Fire lanes maintained and striped. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 503)
	OBSTRUCTION. Access roads not obstructed i.e. parking, dumpsters, building materials. (Re 2021 IFC, Sec. 503)
	KNOX BOX/LOCKS. Provided for all buildings and gates. Padlocks provided when gates are
	used, and property has marked fire lanes. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 506)
	OCCUPANT LOAD SIGNS. Provided where load exceeds 49 in assembly uses. (Ref. 2021 IFC
	Sec. 1004)
	FIRE EXTINGUISHERS. Light Hazard (offices) – 2A10:BC rating within 75' travel, maximum coverage of 3000sqft, Moderate Hazard (retail, manufacturing, warehouse) 2A10:BC within 75 travel, maximum coverage of 1500sqft. Mounted in a visible and accessible leasting. (Bef 200sqft)
	travel, maximum coverage of 1500sqft. Mounted in a visible and accessible location. (Ref. 2027 IFC, Sec. 906)
	EXIT SIGN(S). Exits and exit access doors shall be marked by an approved exit sign readily
	visible from any direction of egress travel. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 1013)
	EXIT SIGN ILLUMINATION . Required when 2 or more exits are required. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 1013)
	EMERGENCY LIGHTING. Required when 2 or more exits are required. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 1008)
	EXIT DOOR SWING. Opens in direction of travel when occupant load exceeds 50 or
	hazardous areas. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 1010)
	EXIT LOCKING HARDWARE. "No knowledge" single action lever or panic bar on all doors.
	The main entrance door may have "key locking" hardware on the door when a sign stating,
	"door shall remain unlocked during business s hours" is posted. Additional deadbolt locks not
	allowed unless connected to the lever. Panic hardware required in Assembly & Educational
	where occupant load exceeds 50. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 1010)
	EXIT SPACING . Exits shall be placed apart at least ½ the diagonal measurement of the
	room. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 1007)
	DEAD END CORRIDORS . Not to exceed 20 feet or 50 if sprinklered. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec.
	1020)
	FIRE SPRINKLERS. (Where installed) Tagged and up to date. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 901)
	FIRE SPRINKLER RISER ACCESS SIGN on exterior and/or interior doors. (Ref. 2021 IFC,
	Chapter 9)
	SPARE SPRINKLERS box, sprinklers, and wrench (s) provided. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Chapter 9)
	FIRE DEPARTMENT CONNECTION (FDC) Sign and caps (Ref. 2021 IFC
	and IPMC, Sec. 704.5)
	FIRE ALARMS. (Where installed) Current inspection tag posted, Operating status should be
	"Normal" at time of inspection. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Chapter 9)
	VENT HOOD. Where Installed. Tagged and up to date. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Sec. 606)
	PAINT BOOTH. Where Installed. Tagged and up to date. (Ref. 2021 IFC, Ch. 24)
	FIRE WALLS. When provided/required between tenant spaces as required by occupancy
	(Assembly).
