# **Dynamic Development Continues**

In EpicCentral, **The Hilton Garden Inn** and **Homewood Suites** hotels operated by Concord Hospitality are now open. Both hotels share the **Grand Prairie Events and Convention Center**. A **Residence Inn by Marriott** is also now open just south of Main Event. **Serious Eats—Shakes, Sliders and Slices** is scheduled to open in May 2024 and the **Dippy Egg** will open in fall 2024.
