HAT works to protect people from natural and man-made harmful chemicals.

What We Do

We research the human health impacts of environmental pollution. We investigate sites where people may come into contact with chemicals. We recommend evidence-based actions to keep people safe.

We work with the Agency for Toxic Substances Disease Registry (ATSDR). With ATSDR, we identify those at risk of exposure to harmful chemicals. And then we work to find solutions to prevent exposure.
