HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD

You can sign up for a Grand Prairie Library card in person at any of our three library locations or mobile libraries. Please bring a valid photo ID. Children and teens must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to register for a card.

New library accounts will be placed in an introductory period for the first three weeks. Accounts will be moved from introductory status after the three-week period as long as they are in good standing.

All items checkout for a period of three weeks. Most items automatically renew for an additional three weeks up to three times as long as they are not on request. Renewal notifications will be sent via e-mail. There is a fee for materials returned late. .25¢ per day, per book and \$1.00 per day, per movie.




