A Message from the Mayor

What a great year 2017 was, and an even better year is ahead in 2018. Our Parks, Arts and Recreation Department won its second Gold Medal award, anointing it best in nation by the National Recreation and Parks Association. WalletHub.com ranked Grand Prairie in the top 50 Best Places to Raise a Family in the U.S. IKEA Grand Prairie opened Dec. 13, 2017, which is attracting major new retail, hotel and restaurant development along SH 161.

- ★ Epic Waters year-round indoor water park is opening end of 2017, a major addition to North Texas tourism.
- ★ The Epic mega-lifestyle center opens early 2018, completely re-imaging health and leisure services in America. The center will feature an artist in residence, inclined track, recording studio, teen center, theater, café, \$1 million in work out equipment, futsal and pickle ball courts, teaching kitchen, bike spin room and swimming pool.
- ★ The extension of SH 360 should be complete in spring 2018, connecting us to US 287, and opening more major development opportunities.
- ★ Several expansions will be complete or begin: Shotwell Library reopens January 2018; Prairie Paws expansion opens summer 2018; and the Warmack Library begins its expansion in 2018.
- ★ PlayGrand Adventures, a playground for people of all abilities, will openlate summer 2018, another big regional draw.
