In the Epic East Town Crossing shopping center on the east side of SH 161 next to Kohls, **Hobby Lobby** will open a store in May 2023 and **Pop Shelf** will open a home goods, seasonal décor and party store in June 2023. **Lucky's Hot Chicken** is scheduled to open next to the new **Dutch Brothers Coffee** on SH 161. **Salad N Go** will open on the east side of SH 161 and Warrior Trail and **Rosa's Mexican Café** is scheduled to open on the southwest corner of Mayfield and SH 161. **Alamo Drafthouse** will open a movie house, restaurant and brewery near SH 360 and I-20 with construction beginning in early 2023. **Braums** will open a new 6,000-square-foot store on the north side of Camp Wisdom, east of Magna Carta. **Jersey Mike's** will open in the Epic West shopping center west of SH 161 and south of Mayfield. **Five Guys** will also open a restaurant in Epic West by January 2023.

In EpicCentral, at SH 161 and Warrior Trail, **Loop 9 BBQ** is opening in February 2023. Several other new restaurants will be opening through the end of 2023. **Bolder Adventure Park** is open inside a 66,000-square-foot air supported dome on Warrior Trail west of SH 161. Check <u>gptx.org/epiccentral</u> for updated information.

Integral Health Holdings will operate the rebranded **Grand Prairie Medical Center** at the site of the former Texas General Hospital west of Great Southwest Parkway and south of Jefferson. The former Texas AirHogs minor league baseball stadium is undergoing a privately funded \$13 million renovation and will open as a **Major League Cricket Stadium** in summer 2023 operated by USA Cricket and Major League Cricket. The 80,000-square-foot stadium near Lone Star Park is scheduled to include a new natural grass field, modification to the seating capacity and additional restrooms.

Message from the Manager

As we complete the first month of Fiscal Year 2022-2023 we have so much to be thankful for. There continues to be strong interest in Grand Prairie for commercial and retail economic development while we continue putting an equal focus on redevelopment. An enhanced Building Blocks program and an incentivization program for some of our city's blighted retail strip centers are among new programs coming forth soon.

We also have many new projects to look forward to this year. Some highlights include:

- Land has been secured to design and build a Fire Station No. 11 at US 287 and SH 360 (timeline to be determined).
- Fire Station No. 6 will be rebuilt
- A new city mobile app and text line will be launched
- The Main Library entrance and lobby will be remodeled
- A new water tower will be built on Robinson Road
- Davis Road will be realigned along with numerous other roadway projects

Also, I am pleased that we were able to offer merit increases beginning October 28 and we plan to continue to make employee compensation a priority for future budgets.
