## **Exceptions:**

- 1) Where 50% or more of the block between intersecting streets on the same side of the street have improvements in them with no sidewalks, then the remaining property owners on the same side of the street are not required to install sidewalks.
- 2) Where street exist with no curb and gutter, then funds equal to the amount to construct standard sidewalks shall be placed in an escrow account with the City for future construction.

### **Recommendations:**

- 1) Where sidewalks would abut a perimeter fence or wall, the pavement shall fill the gap between the column and the fence
- 2) For dedicated trail locations, an allowance should be made for an extended trail or sidewalk.
