Fire Hydrant Painting Project Process:

- 1. Volunteers contact KGPB with proposed date and location of project.
- 2. KGPB will confirm project date and location with volunteers.
- 3. Volunteers reserve materials at least 1 week before the project and schedule pick up date.
 - Pick up may be scheduled for 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday or 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday. Materials may be collected and returned to 1102 MacArthur Blvd, Grand Prairie.
- 4. KGPB staff will meet volunteers on site the morning of the project to train volunteers.
- 5. Volunteers complete project, see **Directions for painting a fire hydrant**, ensure everyone wears proper safety equipment and signs a liability waiver.
- 6. Properly dispose of used materials. All used materials may be tied in a garbage bag and put in with regular household trash once dry.
- 7. Return liability waivers and all materials to KGPB at 1102 MacArthur Blvd, Grand Prairie.

Directions for painting a fire hydrant:

- A. Ensure everyone has safety equipment and has signed a liability waiver.
- B. Use a wire bristle brush to remove any peeling paint.
- C. Use a stiff bristle brush to remove any grass and dirt.
- D. Place cardboard around the base of the fire hydrant to prevent getting paint on the grass or sidewalk.
- E. Paint the fire hydrant using Rust-Oleum V7400 System Fire Hydrant Red.
- F. **Do not** paint the threads of the front and side caps.
- G. Do not paint the grease port on the top (not all hydrants have a grease port).
- H. **Do not** paint the inside of any caps.
- I. Properly dispose of used cardboard, paint stirring stick, and paint brushes. These items may be disposed of with regular household trash once dry.
- J. Return liability waivers and unused/reusable materials.
